What is a Dignity Shop?

Instead of deciding for parents what their children might like or need, we let the parents choose 2-3 items per child. They can choose to wrap the gifts or leave them unwrapped. They can give their children the gifts whenever they choose to celebrate.

We do not have any specific toy or gift suggestions. Please remember we serve a diverse group of families, children range in age from 0-18, we do not accept toy weapons, and we'd prefer gifts to be in the \$15-25 range.

Dignity Shop Volunteer Opportunities

Set-Up Elf: Help set-up the shop! Sort toys, organize tables, set-up gift wrapping stations.

Shopping Elf: With staff guidance, help parents pick out gifts, wrap them if they wish, and carry them back to their room before picking up their children (we have wheeled bins - no heavy lifting required).

Children's Activity Elf: Work with our children's programming staff to keep the children occupied while their parent is shopping. We'll have holiday movies, special snacks, plus crafts kids can make to give to their parents as a gift.
